## 2220 Alfalfa



- 35% Magnum 3801-Wet (Branched Root)
- 25% Survivor (Sunken Crown Root)
- 20% AC Caribou (Tap Root) 15% Abacus (Multifoliate)
- 5% Spyder Alfalfa (Creeping Root)

FEATURES	
Magnum 3801 - Wet Alfalfa	Has a root system structure that is up to 80% branched for optimum performance in poorly drained soils.
Survivor Alfalfa	Has a deeper set crown than most varieties which protects the crown in harsh winters, from heavy machinery and from animal traffic.
AC Caribou Alfalfa	Is a tap root which generally develops downward stocks, 3-5 meters in length. This tends to generate a more resilient plant with higher yields.
Abacus Alfalfa	Is a multifoliate with a high expression percentage resulting in a higher quality feed.
Spyder Alfalfa	Is an improved brand selected for its strong dormancy, excellent winterhardiness and improved disease resistance with the creeping rooted trait.

Alfalfa Blend 2220 is a blend of certified varieties specifically developed to combine the following strengths of our best varieties: high yields, superior winterhardiness, disease resistance, branch root characteristics, sunken crown characteristics, multifoliate characteristics and creeping root characteristics.

The unique strengths of this blend offers suitability to a wide range of conditions faced by growers of quality alfalfa.

Alfalfa Blend 2220 is treated with a 10% phosphate and inoculant coating with apron. The clay based inoculant ensures that the required Rhizobia bacteria are in place for nitrogen fixation. Phosphate helps seedling root development and quick emergence. Apron helps to combat seedling diseases while increasing the establishment success of the stand.
