Description:

Enviro-Green is:

- the result of many years of plant breeding, testing and selection of fine fescue species that grows in all kinds of weather conditions from full sun to heavily shaded areas. This specially designed grass seed blend consists of Certified only varieties of Aberdeen Creeping Red Fescue, Sheep Fescue, Ambassador Chewings Fescue and Oxford Hard Fescue.
- the ultimate seed blend for home lawns, cottages, farm yards or any area where a beautiful low maintenance lawn is required.
- Gives you entry into the new world of environmentally friendly turf species, providing a highly desirable turf stand which is disease resistant, drought tolerant and required less mowing and maintenance than traditional lawns.

Characteristics:

- Enviro-Green is specially designed to produce a dense turf that once established requires very little moisture.
- The dense, thick turf requires less chemicals for weed control. Broadleaf weeds do not compete well with Enviro-Green.
- Yields a natural green colour.
- Enviro-Green's roots go deep, thus requiring less water and over-all maintenance for high quality plant health throughout the life of the turf stand.

Uses:

- An excellent choice for any area where water conservation is a consideration.
- Enviro-Green can be used in any home lawn, slope stabilization project, dike application, commercial turf, parks or recreational areas.
- Use from full sun to heavily shaded areas.

Recommendations:

- Seed at a rate of 4 lbs per 1,000 square feet.
- For slope applications use the proper slope stabilization materials during establishment to eliminate run-off.
- Establish with a high quality starter fertilizer. This will make the roots go deep. We recommend 18-24-12 w 50% Slow release nitrogen. 10 lbs of product per 1,000 square feet.
- Organic Fertilizer option. Apply 20 lbs of Earthworks 5-4-5 Replenish per 1,000 square feet at the same time as seeding.
- Grass seed needs water and light to germinate. Seed shallow and frequent light water for 3-4 weeks until full germination is reached.
- Once established a heavy infrequent watering is ideal.
